

Dr Heather Douglas is an Associate Professor in the Law School, University of Queensland. She researches and teaches in criminal law and procedure. Her PhD examined the work of Justice Martin Kriewaldt and the application of the criminal law to Indigenous people during the assimilation period. Heather has published articles on sentencing in relation to Indigenous customary law, the use of maximum security imprisonment units, domestic violence offenders and on the use of preventive detention. She is the author, with Sue Harbidge, of *Criminal Process in Queensland* (2008, LBC). Heather was a part-time commissioner with the Queensland Law Reform Commission from 2001 until 2007.
